There are over 7,700 restaurants in Orlando. The city is home to some of the world's most elite chefs at the forefront of cutting-edge cuisine.

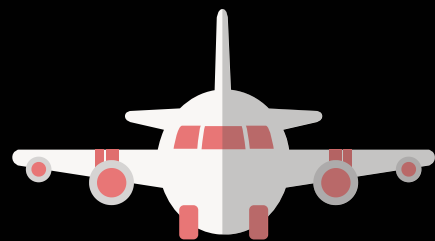
### Green Spaces
